Our Enhanced Mainstream Provision (EMP) provides teaching support and speech and language therapy for up to 20 pupils with speech, language and communication difficulties within a mainstream setting across the primary phase. It is staffed by teachers, teaching assistants and supported by speech therapists.

We are seeking a teacher to provide direct teaching for our older children within the EMP. The role will involve teaching in 'the base' (EMP) each morning, and supporting class teachers in their planning and delivery each afternoon, in order for children to access the wider curriculum at an appropriate level.

You will have:

- Proven experience of teaching children with Specific Educational Needs
- Experience of teaching across the key stages
- Knowledge of assessment systems for children with SEN
